SILVANO FAUSTI, *Atti degli apostoli. Vol. 2, Capitoli 10–18* (Bologna: Dehoniane, 2014, paper €24) 276 pp. ISBN: 978-88-10-21137-3.

This volume continues Fausti's pericope-by-pericope exposition of Acts [see *NTA* 58, p. 580] under the following headings: Acts 10:1-8—"a certain man named Cornelius, a centurion"; 10:9-23—"Get up, Peter, kill and eat!"; 10:24-33—"you have been kind enough to come"; 10:34-43—"the word that God sent to the children of Israel"; 10:44-48—"Can anyone withhold water...?"; 11:1-18—the challenge of those of the circumcision; 11:19-30—"the disciples were called Christians for the first time"; 12:1-17—"tell this to James and the brothers"; 12:18-23—"eaten by worms, he died"; and so forth. The treatment of each passage includes an introduction, a prayerful reflection, a translation of the text of Acts, a commentary, and cross-references. Fausti, author of *Una comunità legge il Vangelo di Giovanni* (2008), was assisted in the preparation of the volume by G. Bertagna.
