Quispe on the new covenant during the controversies in Galilee—a rhetorical and narrative analysis of the sequence in Mk 2:1–3:6; V. R. Solichin on the relationship between the discourses in Mk 4:1-34 and 13:1-37; Oniszczyk on the role of v. 9 in the first appearance of the risen Jesus in Jn 20:1-18; and J. McAuley on the *sequela Christi* of Peter and the Beloved Disciple—composition and interpretation of Jn 21:15-23.
