

NEW TESTAMENT ABSTRACTS

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A. BERNARDO, *Nella terra della Bibbia. Guida della Terra Santa. Bibbia – Storia – Archeologia – Turismo* (3rd ed.; Bologna: Dehoniane, 2013, paper €26.50) 525 pp., frontispiece, folding map. Illustrated. Bibliography. Indexed. ISBN: 978-88-10-82091-9.

The third edition of a work published first in 1998 and then in 2006, this illustrated guide to the Holy Land attempts not only to take account of the pertinent biblical, historical, and archaeological information for the individual sites but also to provide practical information for tourists visiting the sites. After treating general questions, it discusses sites in Galilee (Acco, Banyas and Caesarea Philippi, Mount of the Beatitudes, Beth-shean, Capernaum, Cana, etc.), Samaria (Caesarea Maritima, Nablus, Samaria-Sebaste, Shechem, Mount-Ebal and Gerizim), Jerusalem (the Old City and environs), and Judea (Abu Gosh, Ein-Kerem, the Philistine Pentapolis, Beersheba, Bethany, Bethel, Bethphage, Bethlehem, etc.). An eleven-page glossary is included.
