G. RAVASI, *Commenta. I Quattro Vangeli*. Lettura della Bibbia (Bologna: Dehoniane, 2013, paper €44) 128 pp., 4 CDs. Bibliography. EAN: 80-3357-684-042-0.

This book contains summaries of twenty-five lectures (provided as MP3 files on the accompanying CDs) on the Four Gospels given between 1985-1989. The first three sections (CDs 1-3) cover the Synoptic Gospels: Matthew's Gospel project; the Matthean infancy narrative (Mt 1-2); the Sermon on the Mount (5-7); the other major discourses (10; 13; 18; 24-25); the passion and resurrection according to Matthew; introduction to Mark; from the Jordan to Caesarea Philippi (Mk 1-8); from the transfiguration to Calvary (9-16); the miracles of Jesus in Mark; the passion and resurrection in Mark; Luke's literary, historical, and theological project; the Lukan infancy narrative (Lk 1-2); the journey to Jerusalem (9-19); the passion and resurrection in Luke (20-24); and Luke's most beautiful stories. The fourth and fifth sections (CD 4) treat the Fourth Gospel: enigmas and secrets; the Prologue (Jn 1); Nicodemus, the Samaritan woman, and the royal official (3-4); the "sign" of and discourse on bread (6); light and water at the Feast of Tabernacles (7-9); the Good Shepherd (10); the "hour" of Jesus (10-11); Jesus' last night (13-17); the passion (18-19); and Christ's glorification (20).
